Last month, nearly four hundred thousand Florida workers got a dollar-an-hour raise. It wasn't because employers had suddenly become more generous. In November, Florida voters had approved a ballot initiative to raise the state's minimum wage to \$6.15 an hour-a dollar higher than the federal level. Furthermore, Florida's new minimum wage is pegged to inflation. In the future, the state's lowest-paid workers will receive automatic...




